PLANNING A VISIT TO LINTON ZOO

BOOK YOUR COACH FIRST!

We advise that you book your coach first. This is particularly relevant in the Summer months when coaches get booked up fast. It is unlikely that we will be unable to accommodate you on the date you choose. We are aware that the cost of transport to the zoo is increasing and that often the charge for a bus is much more than the actual zoo admission fee, however we are unable to lower our prices any further to compensate for this.



Although we have many picnic areas and a large covered area, if extremely wet and cold you may prefer to eat on the coach so it is a good idea to check with your coach company to find out if you are allowed to do this.

For a pre-booked group of 20 or more paying people we will give you 1 free supervising adult ticket (age 18+) for every ten paying children.

* **Payment must reach us 10 working days before your visit in one lump sum.** Any additions to the initial payment will be charged the 'on the day' rate.

Payments accepted: bank transfer, school or business cheque, debit card or cash. Cheques should be made out to "Linton Zoo Conservation Park". Credit cards incur a 5% charge. Refunds can be claimed following your visit should any member of your pre-paid party not be able to attend, a £10 administration charge will be applied. A £25 cancellation fee will be applied if a pre-paid group cancels completely.

KEEPER TALKS AND ANIMAL ENCOUNTERS

You can book an interactive, hands-on animal encounter AT NO EXTRA CHARGE for your school group. This interactive session will feature a range of our zoo animals allowing children to get very close to some of the animals. This must be pre-booked.

We have an additional range of different talks and animal encounters available to book. To discuss your needs please telephone the zoo office or email us so we can advise what we believe would be the best talk for you. Additional talks are charged at £50 each.

VIP CLASS VISIT WITH A DEDICATED KEEPER FROM START TO FINISH!

We can provide a keeper dedicated to your group for the duration of your zoo visit (lunch and breaks excluded). This is available for secondary school only, age 11+. Discuss your visit with our experts and get much, much more from your visit. Maybe stop off for a Tiger and Big Cat conservation talk and feel real animal skins (custom seizures). Meet and touch a real live owl, stop off at the reptile house and handle some of our snakes, lizards and bugs. Get a closer look at some of the animals which the keepers can call over to the barriers and let the children ask the keepers lots of questions!

This is recommended for groups of around 30 children. The cost of this special guide is £90. This must be pre-booked and pre-paid and is non-refundable.

GIFT SHOP

Our trained staff will welcome you to our gift shop, but it is useful for us to know if your group is planning to visit the gift shop, this is to ensure we can provide adequate staffing levels to efficiently deal with the larger numbers of children. If we know how much your children have to spend we can offer mini-deals to your group, so they get better value!

GOODY BAGS

Sometimes there just isn't enough time to fit it all in and a trip to the gift shop is often rushed, solve the problem - just grab and dash with your pre-booked goody bags. These can be adapted to suit your group and topic of study. Our standard better value goody bag is £3.50 inc VAT, although we can adapt these depending on your needs, bespoke items start at just 80p for a zoo pencil. So contact the zoo office to discuss your goody bags contents.

FOR THE SAFETY AND ENJOYMENT OF ALL WE NEED TO HAVE SOME RULES:-

- Children should not be allowed to wander unaccompanied at any time.
- Feeding of any animals is not allowed. Each animal has a special diet and should not be given anything else - not even grass!
- Do not, for any reason, climb any fences or cross any safety barriers. If you drop anything over a barrier ask a member of staff to get it for you.
- Please walk quietly around the zoo, so as not to disturb any of the animals who may be nesting or have young.
- Ball games are only allowed in the car parks.

Please remember that a member of your group must go to the gatehouse to confirm numbers and hear any news for the day, before you can gain entry to the zoo.
